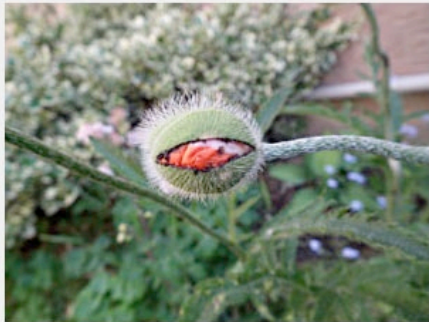
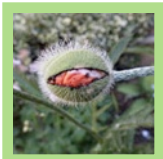


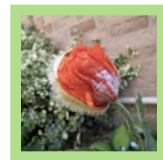
In Full Bloom



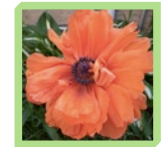
“Recovery - in Full Bloom” - Buds Into Blossoms
